The Alhambra

The Alhambra in Granada dates back to the 9th century. Due to its strategic position overlooking the city, many believe it was first used as a military fortress.

However, in the mid-13th century, the Alhambra became a royal residence with the arrival of the first king of the Nasrid dynasty, Muhammad ben Al-Hamar (Muhammad I, 1238-1273). This event marked the beginning of a glorious period for the Alhambra. During this time, the Watch Tower and the Keep were built.


Many of the constructions we can still see today were carried out by Yusuf I (1333–1354) and Muhammad V (1353–1391). These include the Patio of the Lions, the Justice Gate, the Baths, the Comares Room and the Hall of the Boat.

Most of the palace buildings open into a central courtyard. The newer buildings are connected to the palace buildings with passages and smaller rooms. The decoration of the Alhambra is heavily influenced by Moorish art, but has also changed throughout the years under different rulers. The use of calligraphy, images of vegetation and geometric patterns can be seen throughout the various buildings.

In the 18th century, the Alhambra was abandoned. However, in the 19th century it was rediscovered by European travellers and scholars. A process of repair and preservation began to restore the fortress to the condition in which we see it today. The Alhambra is now one of Spain's major tourist attractions.
