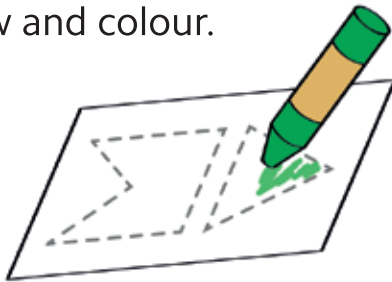
Materials

- Tape



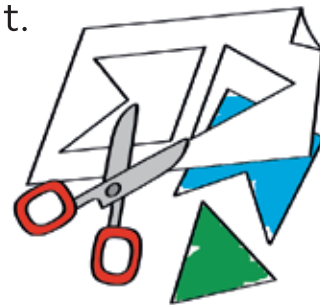

Draw and colour.



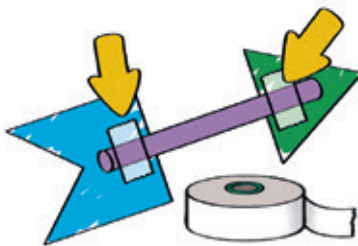
2

Cut out.



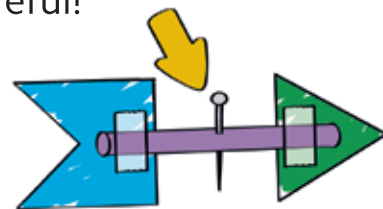
3
