Natural parks in Andalusia

Sierra Nevada

There are many natural parks in Andalusia. One of them is Sierra Nevada National Park. The highest mountain on the Iberian Peninsula is there. It's called Mulhacen. In the park, you can go skiing or visit the lakes.



Doñana

Doñana National Park is a very important place for birds that fly to Europe from Africa. They can find a lot of food in the Guadalquivir river. There are more than 300 types of birds in the park. For example, the flamingos!



Bolonia Beach

In Cádiz, there is a natural park where you can see the dunes. Dunes are made of sand which comes with the wind and stops on the beaches. The dune at the Bolonia Beach is over 30 metres high!



Fun Fact

Doñana National Park is one of the few places in Spain where the Iberian lynx lives in the wild.

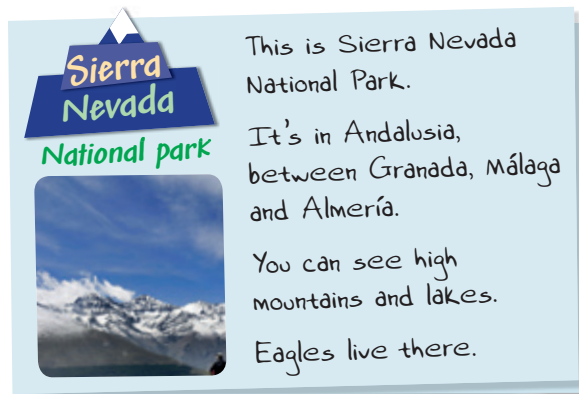

Traditional clothes in...

Hi! I'm Pablo and I'm from Málaga. I like special days when you can wear traditional clothes. Read about some of the traditional clothes in Andalusia.

Traditional clothes in Andalusia

In Andalusia, every region has got special clothes. Look at some traditional clothes from **Málaga**. Women wear a black skirt, a white shirt and a red **belt**. Men also wear a white shirt and a red belt and black trousers.

In **Jaén**, people wear traditional clothes on San Ildefonso Day. Women wear a black jacket, a blue skirt and a blue **apron**. They also wear a red **head scarf**. Men wear a white shirt, black trousers and a black **jacket**. They wear a black hat, too.

In **Almería**, women wear a long, **stripy** skirt with a white apron. They also wear a silk **shawl**. Men wear black trousers and jackets with golden **buttons**.

Fun Fact

In Málaga, there are three types of traditional clothes! They are *marengo*, *verdiales* and *malagueño*.

Hi! I'm Oscar and I'm from Córdoba. There's a lot of great food here. Let's take a look at some typical dishes!

- 1 **BEFORE** What are your favourite traditional dishes?

This is *salmorejo*, a cold soup. It's made with tomatoes, **garlic**, bread and **olive oil**. You eat it with **ham** and **boiled eggs**.

If you like ham and cheese, you should try a *flamenquin*. It's a **roulade** made of pork, ham and cheese. It's often served with **French fries**. It's delicious!

French fries

A typical dish from Andalusia is bull tail stew, or *rabo de toro estofado*. Now it's popular in many places around Spain, not only in Andalusia. It's usually served with **boiled potatoes** or rice.

Fun Fact

Salmorejo is served cold and many people think you only eat it on hot days. But in fact you can eat it all year round.

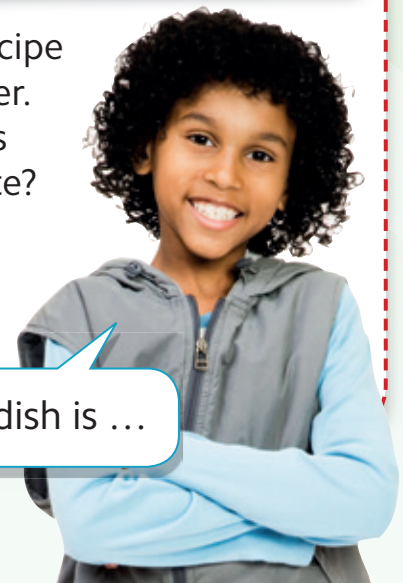
Churros and hot chocolate
